A Better Eurobodalla (ABE) notes the recent statement on 12th November 2020 by MP for Bega Andrew Constance, indicating that a new foreshore walking track will be constructed by Eurobodalla Council from Observation Point in Batehaven stretching south along the intervening headlands to Pretty Point.

Andrew Constance's announcement and a subsequent posting on Council's own webpage at <https://www.esc.nsw.gov.au/inside-council/project-and-exhibitions/major-projects-and-works/current-projects/infrastructure-and-planning/batemans-bay-coastal-walking-trail> indicate that \$5.2 million of funding towards this project has been secured from the Bushfire Local Economic Recovery (BLER) Fund.

Given community interest in the significant allocation of these bushfire recovery funds, as well as some uncertainty regarding the proposed route of the track, we request that Eurobodalla Council provide ABE with a copy of the project application documents submitted for funding under the BLER fund.

We look forward to your response to this request for information regarding this significant community project.
