Candidate Update
In early May, ABE met with Eurobodalla Greens candidates who will be standing for the Council elections on 4 September.The Eurobodalla Greens launched their ticket of 4 at the end of April along with the key issues that they will take to the elections: the need for council to be more accountable to residents and ratepayers; improving the liveability of the shire through creating safer, better connected and more resilient communities; and environmental responsibility by working with council staff to take action on climate

ABE previously met with Councillor Anthony Mayne who is seeking reelection. We understand that he has now finalised his ticket which will be launched in June. We hope to meet with him and other candidates on his ticket then.

In early May, ABE once again presented to Council's Public Access Session on an issue that has been raised often with us by the community – the alienation of public assets. We provided examples and spoke about the poor public consultation practices and lack of transparency associated with these events.
